Water Supply

The key element of each project is to develop a dependable source of abundant uncontaminated water. We carry out projects at churches, schools or camps where there is a demonstrated need for clean, dependable water.

The Water & Sanitation Ministry



Groundwater wells provide abundant, clean water

constructs wells, develops springs and builds treatment systems to provide abundant, clean water. As the project progresses, the local population invariably takes interest. This gives the team a chance to share their testimony and the love of Jesus Christ.

Project Construction

Most projects include a drilled well or development of an existing spring. Many times, the project includes a submersible electric pump to lift water to a tank, providing running water. Other projects include a hand pump.

In areas where the subsurface is very rocky and springs are present, we develop surface water as a water supply. This usually involves construction of a spring box to protect the water source and piping to the homes, schools and churches that will use the water.

Improved Sanitation

Having a well with plentiful water is a blessing, but the real advantage is the improved sanitation that is provided. When you have to carry all the water that your family uses from a half mile away, using it for washing is not high on the list!

The sanitation aspects of the projects typically include a wash station for the community and the church members. This can be a great blessing for ladies who often must carry their clothes to the nearest river or stream to wash. If space and funds allow, we also install a "modern" bathroom with a flush toilet and shower.
